0 0 0 T 0 0	FISHBOWL	Inner group holds discussion while outer group observes and later gives feedback on patterns, themes etc.
	PYRAMID	-Individual task, e.g. write  -Share ideas in pairs  -Introduce partner's ideas; look for patterns in group  -Draw out principles, guidelines, criteria, action points
To S	BUZZGROUP	Pairs talk for 5 minutes each way. For example: "Share your definition of; an experience"; etc."
