









Some working structures in groups

	<p>FISHBOWL</p> 	<p>Inner group holds discussion while outer group observes and later gives feedback on patterns, themes etc.</p>
	<p>PYRAMID</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Individual task, e.g. write -Share ideas in pairs -Introduce partner's ideas; look for patterns in group -Draw out principles, guidelines, criteria, action points
	<p>BUZZGROUP</p> 	<p>Pairs talk for 5 minutes each way. For example: "Share your definition of...; an experience"; etc."</p>
	<p>CROSSOVER GROUPS</p> 	<p>During the first period of discussion, participants are allocated different numbers or letters in each group. For the second period they form new groups comprising identical numbers/letters, possibly to report and discuss what emerged in the first group.</p>
