Description of the training situation:

Each of the two groups of participants has two 45-minute training sessions running once a week during two weeks. The first training session is preceded by a short orientation during which the students familiarize themselves with the LEA project (in brief), the aims and objectives of the proposed activities. Then they complete the activities, fill out short evaluation sheets at the end of each worksheet. Upon completion of the entire set of activities they have an informal workshop during which they compare notes and provide feedback.
