



... Strong feelings against the Reform

Challenges

1. How to keep track of students???

2. How to offer training to new teachers?

3. How to support teachers of year 1?

Considerations

- 1. impossible to keep track of 10,000 or more students
- 2. need to focus on trainers and teachers: offer of 2nd level face-to-face courses for 150 teachers
- 3. solution: publishing house for training courses on web-based learning platform
